

## **USADA DCO Coronavirus Protection Precautions**





Before this sample collection session, your USADA DCO completed a **health evaluation questionnaire**, which is required each day that they test for USADA and further determines their clearance to conduct the assignment.





If you feel more comfortable completing the sample collection process at a different location than where you are notified, you can request to relocate to another location.





During this sample collection session your USADA DCO and other sample collection personnel present will be **wearing a mask at all times**.






During this sample collection session your USADA DCO and other sample collection personnel present will be **wearing a face shield after notification has occurred**.





After notification, you, your USADA DCO and any other sample collection personnel present will need to **wash your hands with soap and water.** Hand sanitizer may be used, and will be supplied by your USADA DCO if soap and water is not available.





During this sample collection session your USADA DCO and other sample collection personnel present will **practice social distancing** to the extent possible, consistent with the testing location.





Your USADA DCO is equipped with disinfectant and will be **disinfecting all surfaces** on which collection equipment is placed, any mutually used items, and the iPad on which information about the sample collection session is collected. If documentation is completed on paper, your USADA DCO will disinfect the pen prior to each use or provide you with a separate disinfected pen.





While the CDC notes that regular use of hand sanitizer is more effective than the use of gloves, your **DCO may also wear sanitary gloves** at times when they are not using the iPad for data entry.





At the end of the test session, your USADA DCO will **discard all trash and disposable PPE items** in the provided trash bag and **disinfect the processing station** before leaving.
